Through a range of experiential outdoor activities, age-appropriate book recommendations, and open-ended questions, children will develop a sense of wonder and curiosity about their environment. Celebrate LAND Project is designed to evolve with growing minds over a multi-year period, providing new challenges, memories, and opportunities to revere the natural world.



How to Celebrate LAND

Families may visit the Celebrate LAND Project website to order packets from concept areas such as *Mountains are Magnificent* and *Trees are Terrific*. Where applicable, families may participate through local facilitators such as summer camps and school/library programs. CLP packets will also be available through local sponsors like farmers markets and small businesses.

Each packet consists of five activities and is available at a K - 2nd or 3rd - 5th grade level. Upon accomplishing three or more activities in a concept area (packet), children submit photographs of their learning to the CLP website. Volunteer high school students and senior citizens will review each submission and respond directly to participants! Children have the opportunity to earn collectible prizes through their work.

Annual, in-person celebrations will take place at a variety of New England venues like Smokey House Center in Danby, VT. Three new concept areas, with accompanying activities and book lists, will be introduced each year!
